The next event for the Friends will be *Spring into Gardening*, an annual event staged by the City of Stonnington for the community. It's a day to meet your neighbours and garden enthusiasts and is an important day for the Friends to promote our work and highlight the historical value, plants, and features of Victoria Gardens. In recent years there has been an increasing interest in sustainable gardening and water recycling. Many stands display information on water wise gardening and plant selection.

Spring into Gardening: Sunday 10th October, 11 am – 4.00pm

Having just returned to Melbourne after almost 2 months away, it is wonderful to see Victoria Gardens, and all our landscapes and trees, drenched with lots of rain after so many years of drought. The Gardens are looking lush and very colourful at the moment. A plant providing significant colour is the Kaffir Lily, *Clivia miniata* with red upright flowers and *Clivia* x *cyrtanthiflora* with salmonorange flowers. Named in 1828 after Lady Charlotte Clive, 30th Duchess of Northumberland. Clivia is a South African plant from the Natal region that has become popular in recent years due to its ability to grow well in dry shade and which requires low amounts of water.
