This is the first Newsletter for 2012, due to my absence for several months. Despite attempts to get new members into the positions of President, Secretary, Public Officer and Treasurer at the 2011 AGM, and again in the November newsletter, these calls have gone unanswered.

The 2012 Annual General Meeting has been arranged for Tuesday 9 October at 64 Bendigo Street, at 7.45pm. Members are advised that this will be the FINAL meeting (and demise of the Friends group) unless we have new nominations for office bearers to carry the Friends into the future. Over the years the Council has deferred to us as a consultative body and where possible have sought to implement our recommendations. It would be a great loss to the community to lose this influence. You will have recently seen Tree Removal notices on the High Street and Murray Street gates. The notice is for the removal of a declining Bhutan Cypress and Arizona Cypress near the Depot entrance, a Willow Myrtle in poor condition east of the old fountain base, and 4 Glossy-leaved Privet trees west of the High Street entrance and in the east shrubbery south of the large Chinese Elm.

In early August the two declining London Plane (*Platanus* x *acerifolia*) trees at the southern end of the sunken oval were removed and 2 advanced trees were replanted on the 17 August 2012.
